## **1301 Florida/2300 13<sup>th</sup> Street and 1303 to 1349 Florida Avenue, NW Washington, DC**

The project consists of a block of brick row houses of 1303-49 Florida Avenue and the adjoining brick commercial/residential structure of 1301 Florida / 2300 13<sup>th</sup> Street, NW in Washington, D.C. The entire block was erected 1910-11 by father and son Charles W. King and Charles W. King, Jr. Property architect was the Washington, DC firm of N.T. Haller.

The properties consist of lots 80-104 in Charles W. King's Addition to Columbia Heights, District of Columbia, now known as lots 80-104 in Square 2868.

### **General Architectural Description**

Vernacular Classical Revival with Neo-Greco influences can describe the architectural style of the block of buildings stretching along the north side of the length of Florida Avenue, NW between 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> streets. The characteristics of the building exhibit various influences of the Greek, Georgian, Italianate, and Arts and Crafts styles are evident in the architecture of the block.

#### **1301 Florida / 2300 13<sup>th</sup> Street**

This building consists of a three story structure consisting of a two part commercial block. The first story, opening and facing Florida Avenue, is devoted to commercial activity. The second and third stories, each consisting of a single apartment, have access provided on the 13<sup>th</sup> Street side. The Florida Avenue side of the building displays 3 bays while the 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue side exhibits a seven bay face.

#### **Exterior Walls –**

The southern and eastern facing walls are laid in American or Common Bond pattern consisting of red pressed brick. The brick first story, southern and eastern facing walls, used for commercial purposes, is currently painted white while the remainder of the structure displays the original finish.

#### **Rear Wall –**

The rear wall facing an adjoining alley consists of soft red brick laid in American or Common Bond with five stretcher rows per header row.

*Front Windows and Doors –*

*Commercial Storefront* –The commercial storefront projects as a one story wide bay southward into the public space approximately 2.5 feet. Storefront windows consisting of four main plate glass panels, topped by four corresponding transom panels rise above a base consisting of brick panels. Double wooden doors, framed with single light windows filling the upper two-thirds, open into the commercial space facing Florida Avenue. Wear and paint build up on the doors suggest the doors probably date to the construction of the building.

South facing (Florida Avenue) upper story windows, three on each floor, consist of double hung sashes of six light over a single light sashes. Rectangular sandstone lintels and sills frame each opening.

*Windows/Side and Rear –*

East facing windows (13<sup>th</sup> Street), exhibit the same characteristics as the south side with the exception of first, lower commercial level windows, which consist of six, two light openings two of which are boarded over. Near the center of the 13<sup>th</sup> Street face, located on the second and third stories are two windows located to the south of the 13<sup>th</sup> Street residential door. Both windows, framed by sandstone lintels and sills, consist of one, one over one light opening, and one, two over two light, double hung windows.

Rear windows facing the alley are located adjacent to the second and third story rear entrance doors. These windows consist of two narrow, one over one light windows opening (bathrooms) and a two over two light double hung window sashes. The rear windows rest on rectangular sandstone sills and are supported overhead by Italianate-influenced flush soft brick uncommon rowlock lintels.

*East Facing Residential Door –*

This door consists of a frame surrounding an opening consisting of a 24-light window, seven rows of three lights each. This door gives the appearance that it is original to the construction of the building.

*Parapets/Cornices, Trim and Rooflines –*

The building exhibits a flat roofline which is hidden from view by a projecting wooden capped Classical Revival-influenced trimmed cornice sporting short projecting brackets. Below the brackets is found a continuous egg and dart scroll moldings.

## 1303 to 1349 Florida Avenue

This block consists of 24 individual contiguous brick row houses consisting of two main stories over an English basement which faces Florida Avenue. Each row house is two bays wide.

### **Exterior Walls –**

#### **Front –**

The front, south facing Florida Avenue wall of the entire block, 1303-49, consists of an eight-inch pressed veneer brick face laid in Flemish bond of headers and stretchers. Seven of the 24 row house fronts retain the original surface free of paint. Headers are glazed which stretchers do not thus providing a checkerboard pattern. There is no break in the wall from 1303 to 1349. It was laid as a continuous wall at the same time.

#### **Sides and Rear –**

The rear and side walls facing an adjoining alley consists of soft red brick laid in American or Common Bond with five stretcher rows per header row.

The entire exposed western wall of 1349, likewise is laid with the same brick pattern and materials. At the top of this wall is a projecting brick corbel that mimics, in part, the cornice brackets along the Florida Avenue face of the buildings.

#### **Windows and Doors/Front –**

*English Basement* -Although many of the lower story windows are not visible from the street today, several that are exposed consist of two over two double hung sashes framed by a sandstone sill and are supported overhead by Italianate-influenced flush soft brick uncommon rowlock lintels.

Likewise, lower level doors for many of the units are not visible. The door at 1349 appears original and consists of four recessed wood panels.

*First Floor –* A variety of windows currently exist for the 24 units. Eight units, however, display what appears to be original frame, double hung sashes consisting of 12 lights over two. Rectangular sandstone lintels and sills frame these, single first floor openings.

Eight of the units display first floor doors that contain a single light pane filling three-fourths of the door opening somewhat similar to the 24-light residential door opening

facing 13<sup>th</sup> Street and also similar in size to the openings exhibited by the double commercial doors at 1301.

*Second Floor* – Likewise, a variety of windows currently exist for the 24 units. Seven units, however, display what appear to be the original frame double hung sashes consisting of nine lights over two. Rectangular sandstone lintels and sills frame these second floor openings.

**Windows/Side and Rear –**

*Window Openings* - 1303-1349 Although many of the window openings today exhibit changes, enough of the units display two over two double hung sashes framed by a rectangular sandstone sill and overhead by Italianate-influenced flush soft brick uncommon rowlock arched lintels to say this is probably the original finish. Two windows from the center, dining room and upper story bedroom face the rear alley. The rear section of each house that originally contained a bath on each floor as well as the kitchen and a bedroom exhibit the same window features. A setback for each unit is paired to provide the light well for the dining room/bedroom window openings. Along the length of the walls facing the light well are two smaller, narrow single light over single light double hung sashes providing openings to the bathrooms on each floor. A third window consisting of a two light single sash opening provides light to the kitchen. This window, likewise, rests on a rectangular sandstone sill and is supported above by uncommon rowlock arched lintels.

**Porches –**

Physical evidence suggests the original porches for the row houses of 1303-1349 were separated at the point where buildings were elevated to maintain a consistent grade to the street level. There are four such rises consisting of from one brick to two bricks high. It may also be that the porches were paired into 12 units mirroring the pairing of the 24 row houses into 12 architectural pairs. Further evidence hints at original porch floor surfaces consisting of wood. Addresses 1303-05 display this arrangement. Other breaks in the porch roof line further up the street would also hint at this arrangement. It is also possible that multiple units were tied together as front windows heights are not consistent from one end of the block to the other. As the block moves westward, the buildings rise slightly to maintain a consistent grade line to the street below.

Several of the porches display a wood cornice over a frieze molding. The porch framing rests on porch posts, some shared between addresses and others not.

*Porch Posts/Supports* – Evidence suggests the presence of narrow full height Ionic columns supporting the porch units. In some instances today, half height Ionic columns rest on American or Common Bond brick pedestals. In others, full, square brick piers rise to the porch frieze and, a few, consist of modern, 4" by 4" treated wood posts.

*Access Stairways –*

Each unit is reached by a series of concrete steps framed by pressed brick retaining walls. Each stairway rises, on average, eight steps to a slight level plane, then rises another eight steps to reach the front porches. The second series of steps with supporting walls stand completely above grade. Since this treatment is displayed by all 24 units, it is likely this is the original design.

*Front Cornices, Trim and Rooflines –*

The row houses between 1303 through 1349 exhibits a flat roofline on one unit paired with a second displaying a Greek Temple inspired projecting false front gable wall that rises above the roofline building roofline. The temple roofline is capped by a wood cornice marked at each end by a cornice return. The cornice ends are supported by small cornice brackets. The temple face is broken by a centered circular lunette vent.

Each flat roof is capped with a Classical Revival-influenced trimmed cornice sporting short projecting brackets.

Narrow brick piers rise above the roofline as an architectural element providing visual separation between each unit. The pier stack extends from a corbelled base projecting outward from the main wall face. Near the top of each parapet is a projecting course of bricks mimicking a chimney. To the rear extends a short brick firewall between each unit.

## **Historical Significance of 1301 Florida/2300 13<sup>th</sup> Street and 1303 to 1349 Florida Avenue, NW, Washington, DC**

The contiguous block of row houses anchored by one commercial/apartment building, all located along the north side of Florida Avenue, NW, between 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Streets in Washington, D.C., represents the broad development of urban row house construction shortly after the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The development took place at a time when American urban centers were spreading outward along, or near, designated public transportation lines.

The construction materials displayed by these properties clearly point towards a design plan tailored for the clerical, or working class. And, the social history, residential occupancy and ownership of these properties mirror that of many developments of the time when property covenants limited the individuals who could and would live in a particular neighborhood or community.

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After the end of the Civil War, great change and growth came to Washington City in the District of Columbia. The increased numbers of government workers and government functions did not cease at the end of the war.

At about the same time, streetcars made their appearance in the nation's capitol. Beginning in 1862, horse drawn trolley cars left the capital and mall along two major northern routes, 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> streets. Soon commercial and residential growth followed.

This growth was further increased by the 1893 arrival of an electric streetcar, The Rock Creek Railway Company that offered service along U Street tying together the two northern routes and extending service further northward to the community of Chevy Chase.

Between 1870 and 1910 Washington's population grew from 115,415 to 302,798, an almost threefold increase in forty years.

During this period of growth, the northern limits of Washington City at Boundary Street, now known as Florida Avenue, proved to be the edge of the city in name only. Multiple subdivisions were platted and developed in the area of Columbia Heights, Mt. Pleasant and Lanier Heights in the central section of the north western quadrant of the District.

Another factor enhancing growth north of Boundary/Florida was Columbian University which was located on a plot of ground known as College Hill, near the present day intersection of University and Fairmount avenues. The school moved to Foggy Bottom in 1913 eventually becoming today's George Washington University. The former campus was quickly subdivided as University Park.

In July 1909 the land just north of Florida Avenue, NW bounded on the east by 13<sup>th</sup> Street and on the west by 14<sup>th</sup> Street, extending northward beyond Belmont Street, was subdivided by the Columbia Heights Realty Company into residential lots and four apartment buildings named The Belmar, The Montclair, The Hoyt (in honor of Company official Alfred W. Hoyt), and the Hoffman.

The realty company, did not, however, immediately build or develop along the southern boundary of Florida Avenue.

One year later, however, county commissioners were asked to accept another recording of the plat consisting of lots 80-104 from real estate developer Charles W. King. Accepted by the commissioners on October 25, 1910, King lost no time in developing the property.

On the same date, King secured a building permit to construct two story brick row houses with English basements constituting addresses of 1311 to 1347 Florida Avenue, NW. Less than one month later on November 22, King secured a second permit to construct a three story, commercial and residential block at 1301 Florida/2300 13<sup>th</sup> Street, four more row houses between the new commercial block and the previously approved row and one final row house on the narrowing sliver of land at the western end of the block, this address becoming 1349 Florida Avenue.

Although it is not recorded as to why the building permits were secured in the manner in which they were, it is probable that the developer intended to construct the center of the block initially using the eastern section as a staging area. It is also probable that after the project was situated, he realized that there was, indeed, room on the western edge of the project to site one more dwelling. All of this, however, is pure conjecture on the author's part.

The building permit noted that the architect for the project was the firm of N.T. Haller, owned by Nicholas T. Haller. This wasn't the first time King and Haller collaborated. Earlier projects included the row houses of 1722 to 1758 Seaton Street, about five blocks west of this project and there were probably others as well.

Haller, along with several other architects, was described by a publication of the D. C. Preservation League as "some of the city's most prolific turn-of-the-century architects."

According to historian Pamela Scott, Haller first appears in city directories in 1877 when his vocation is listed as a carpenter residing in the 1300 block of 9<sup>th</sup> Street, NW. Beginning in 1883, he apparently was licensed as an architect as all further directory entries list that as his vocation. His offices were located at various locations including the Wardern Building by the mid-nineties, a commercial Richardsonian Romanesque structure he designed, which was erected on the southeast corner of 9<sup>th</sup> and G Streets, NW. Today, known as the Atlas Building, the structure was recently renovated as part of the new Spy Museum complex. Later business addresses included the Corcoran Building

and finally, 1916-17, the business address is the McLachlen Building. This was the last year either Haller or the business appears in the listings.

By the turn of the century, he was also living in the Columbia Heights section of the city, the family's longtime address listed as 447 Lamont Avenue, N.W.

In the 1899 city directory, Charles W. King, Senior was living at 459 Massachusetts Avenue, NW., with a contracting business address of 1416 F Street, NW. His son, Charles W. King, Jr., was associated with the firm of King and Brother, a business for which no additional information was discovered. At that time, the younger King was residing at 419 I Street, NW.

By the time the Florida Avenue project construction was underway, the elder King was listed as a Realtor in the city directory with offices in the Southern Building and a residence at 1431 Fairmont Avenue, NW, just about three blocks from the project site. The younger King was listed as a contractor with offices at 920 New York Avenue, NW, and a residence at 1519 Monroe Street, located about six blocks north of the project site.

Deeds of Sale for the Florida Avenue properties recorded in 1910 through 1912 were signed by Charles W. King and Alice W. King, his wife. While it is not recorded if father and son worked together on projects, the likelihood is great since Charles Sr.'s vocation listed in the city directory changed during this period from contractor to Realtor. Likewise, it is during this period that the younger King is listed independently as a contractor, or builder.

The 1920 District census enumeration reveals more about the King families. The elder King, age 78, resided at the Fairmont Avenue address with a daughter, Alice M., age 17, and Wineil Nihl, a 33 year old property maintenance worker, Teresi Nihl, 32, his wife, a maid, and their four-year-old daughter, Frances E. The parents, non-residents, were natives of Hungary. The daughter was born in the District.

The absence of Alice W. would suggest his wife died by that time. The age of their daughter, also Alice, at age 17 would suggest quite a spread of years between husband and wife.

Further, the age of son, Charles W., Jr., at age 50, at this time would suggest Alice W., was the elder King's second wife.

Charles W. King, Jr., resided at 1519 Monroe Street, with his wife, Carrie J., age 46, and daughter, Marian L., age 24. All were natives of the District of Columbia. A housekeeper, Anna Kurtz, age not listed, was a native of Hungary.

The younger King continues to appear in city directories up through the early 30s. By 1940, however, references to both he and his wife disappear from the scene.

Although the Kings developed the property, they did not serve as landlords. Most of the early sales of the residential properties occurred within the first two years of construction. However, they were not all sold to owner occupants. One purchaser, Harry S. Thomas, purchased lots 88, 89, 90 and 92 in May of 1912. In another case, a new owner-occupant, Henry Hile, lived in one residence and rented the other out for decades.

The initial wave of new residents was primarily of the working clerical classes. Several worked at the government printing office, one was a bar tender, another a motorman, an Italian shoe repair shop owner and several households were headed by women, perhaps they were widows as they did not appear to have outside vocations. Two initial residents were a dentist and a drugstore owner. Since both appeared in the city directory at these addresses a single year each, and neither appears on property records as owning the residences, it is probable they were residing there temporarily as new, suburban homes were under construction.

The ownership of the commercial/apartment building of 1301 Florida/2300 13<sup>th</sup> Street, went through just three owners following the initial purchase of the property from King by Charles Woods Taylor in 1911. The list of owners is not nearly as long as the number of commercial concerns that occupied the building over the years. City directories reveal the site as home to the following businesses over the years: several groceries, a deli, a bookstore, dry cleaners, and barber shop. Several years, including a few during the Great Depression list the business room as “vacant.”

Since these properties were just a mere three blocks north of the commercial and professional center of the African American community along U Street, just a five minute walk to the famed Lincoln Theater and the True Reformer/Odd Fellows Hall, a natural question to ask is what race was the owners and residents of this block of properties. Both the 1920 and 1930 census records indicate all residents were White or Caucasian.

Although considered the heart and soul of the segregated Jim Crow-era African American community, records indicate there were entire blocks in the area that were either populated by blacks or whites.

Deed abstracts in the Recorder of Deeds Office beginning in the 30s' began to hint at the possible race of residents of odd numbered houses in the 1300 block of Florida Avenue, Northwest. A 1938 transaction for lot 88 states the sale is "subject to all covenants of record." Several abstracts of transactions from the 1940s reveal the same. Most notably, however, an abstract for a 1947 Deed of Trust, also for lot 88, states, "subject to racial and other covenants of record."

This smoking gun, a legal document between James Warren Dickens et ux and the American Security & Trust Company (L 8469, F 522, I-16966) states,

lot numbered 88 in Charles W. King's Subdivision of Lots in Block Numbered 29, "Columbia Heights" now known as square numbered twenty-eight hundred and sixty-eight (2868), is per plat recoded in the office of the Surveyor for the District of Columbia in Libre 41 at Folio 40, subject to the covenants that no building erected on said lot shall be for manufacturing or mechanical purposes, nor shall any spirituous liquors be sold therein; and subject to the further covenant that said lot shall never be sold, leased, rented or occupied by any person or persons of Negro or Mongolian birth or having Negro or Mongolian blood.

A check of the original Deed of Sale between King and Ida L. Smith, original owner of lot 99 containing 1349 Florida Avenue reveals the same telling covenant language.

Additional research is warranted, but as the booklet *Strivers' Section Historic District* authored by Kimberly Prothro Williams notes, "By 1900...African American residents could be found along Swann, and T Street....and the west end of Seaton Street." This likely means that the 1902 collaboration between architect Haller and builder/developer King on the western end of this single block street, likewise, contained similar covenant language.

In January 1948 the Supreme Court of the United States heard oral arguments in the case of *Shelley v. Kramer*, a Missouri case regarding similar property deed restrictions. When the decision was announced on May 3, 1948, the Justices struck down such documents.

After the court decision, the next legal document recorded for these properties covered a 1952 sale of lots 93 and 95. At that time, the deed language notes the sale is "subject to covenants of record, or such of same as are now of legal force and effect." On the cover of the deed book (L 9700), is stamped "Racial Covenants are null, void and illegal under our laws."

The gates were opened and, as such, the racial makeup of 1300 Florida Avenue changed over the next five decades.

While the openness of residential and eventually, shopping selections as well, spelled doom for the businesses and professional offices along nearby U Street, the racial transition of the neighborhood to one predominantly African American was strengthened when the District of Columbia's School Board decided to convert the previously, all white Central High School (1916) to the segregated African American School, Cardoza High School, in 1950.

And, although the schools were later legally integrated, flight from the city core and riots following the assassination of Martin Luther King in April 1968, propelled the entire neighborhood into a long period of decline.

Efforts to revitalize the area were, for the most part, unsuccessful until the U Street/Cardoza Metro Stop was opened in the late 90s. In December of 1998 the area was included in the Greater U Street Historic District, consisting of both a local designated district providing design review and a National Register District.



Flemish Bond front wall runs uninterrupted a series of 14 row houses, from one end of the block to the other.



Seven other structures, out of 24, exhibit the original window sashes.




## Plate 8




